IIT Bombay Receives Generous Gift

The Applied Materials, Inc., USA, the global leader in nano-manufacturing technology solution for the electronic industry, has pledged a generous gift of equipment and technology to the Nanotechnology Centre at IIT Bombay. The equipment, costing 3.5 million US dollars, will consist of AMAT Cluster Tools for different process modules (such as Rapid Thermal Processing, Lower Pressure CVD, High k, DPN, RIE, Ashing Chamber, PVD Chamber, Degas Chamber, Preclean Chamber) and have different process capabilities and applications. The equipment will be housed in the Nanotechnology Centre. In recognition of this goodwill from the Applied Materials, Inc., IIT Bombay has decided to name the laboratory that will house the equipment as "Applied Materials Nano-manufacturing Laboratory". Also, a recognition plaque will be installed in the lobby of the Nanotechnology Centre acknowledging the donor's generous contribution in promoting research in Nanotechnology. This gift has been made possible through the IIT Bombay Heritage Fund.

Mr. Michael R. Splinter, President and Chief Executive Officer of this company, is a 30-year veteran of the superconductor manufacturing operations in the world. He has been at the forefront of many of the industry's most significant technology innovations and transitions. Mr. Splinter will be visiting IIT Bombay during October-November 2007 to inaugurate the Applied Materials Nano-manufacturing Laboratory. On this occasion, an MoU for collaborative R&D projects will be signed between IIT Bombay and Applied Materials Inc., USA.

IIT Bombay - Keio University to collaborate

The Keio University, Japan, and Indian Institute of Technology Bombay signed a Memorandum of Understand on August 21, 2007, Prof. Ashok Misra. Director, ITT Bombay, and Prof. Yuichiro Anzal, President, Keio University, signed the MoU.
